Ms. Connie Dejak the President and Chief Executive Officer of Runnymede Healthcare Centre invites us all to reflect on the significance of this day with the patients at Runnymede Healthcare Centre, many of whom served during our country's time of need.

The ceremony will begin at 2:00pm with The Queens Own Rifles, Canada's oldest continuous infantry regiment, marching into the hospital adorned in 1860's uniform, to the buglers playing the skirmishers call. The bugle band will then perform the Last Post followed by a reading of In Flanders Fields and a 2 minute silence. Please join us as we come together to remember and honour those men and women who sacrificed their lives in military service.

Runnymede Healthcare Centre has a long history of expertise in the care of individuals with specialized complex continuing care needs.
